	Ensure centre has co-mingled recycling, apply for extra recycling bins – see commercial services form		
	Source green waste bin service for garden and food waste – see commercial services form		
	Set up green trays in the craft area for children to use one-sided paper as scrap paper		
	Set up a <u>compost</u> bin for food waste		
	Promote waste-free lunch days – <u>see low waste lunch checklist</u>		
	Purchase sustainable items like recycled paper towels and toilet paper		
	Sign up to electronic subscriptions to reduce mail		
	Conduct a waste audit, using our how to do a waste audit sheet		
	Recycle mobile phones, CDs and DVDs, smoke alarms, light globes and household batteries at Council's admin building and various <u>Libraries</u>		
	Participate in free NSW EPA Chemical Clean Out days across the region		
	Collect items such as toothpaste tubes and bread tags though <u>TerraCycle</u> and receive funding for your school		
	Take an excursion to the Organic Resource Recovery facility at Awaba to learn more about the composting process and waste management

	Educate students and staff about how to save water (turning taps off, using half-flush etc)		
	Install a rainwater tank for gardening and toilets		
	Install sensor, mechanical or push timers on taps		
	Add mulch to gardens to reduce water needs – see tips for making mulch		
	Repair water leaks

	Conduct a water audit of your school

	Conduct an energy audit to analyse energy bills, audit appliances and record daily energy use		
	Visit <u>Solar my School</u> for purchasing solar system. Install solar panels and solar hot water, or a heat pump – <u>see guide for solar panels</u>		
	Ensure all computers, printers, photocopiers, air conditioners and lights are switched off at the end of the day and turn lights off at night and during breaks		
	Use a standby switch (available at hardware stores)		
	Replace old light globes with efficient globes such as LEDs.		
	Install movement sensor lighting, and ensure external security lights are on a sensor		
	Use a simple programmable timer to switch off emptied fridges on weekends, and during school holidays		
	Encourage students and staff to dress appropriately for each season to save on heating and cooling costs		
	Only use an air conditioner when natural ventilation is inadequate, and ensure doors and windows are closed		
	Use a thermometer to ensure your air conditioner is efficient. The temperature should be 18-21C in winter and 23-26°C in summer		
	Use door snakes and window seals to reduce draughts		
	Check Ausgrid for energy-saving material
