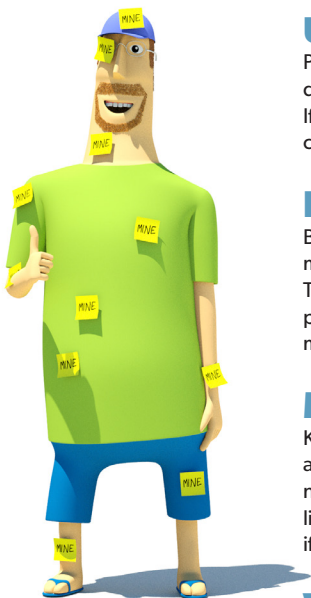
## LABEL IT



Property that is clearly marked with proof of ownership can help prevent home burglary because thieves know it is harder to sell.

It is also easier for Police to return stolen property when the rightful owner can be identified.

**Follow four simple steps for the best in property marking home security.**



### USE A UNIQUE CODE

Police suggest adding NSW to your driver licence number (eg, NSW1234XX). If you don't have a driver licence, you can create your own unique code.

### LABEL IT

Be sure to use a property marking method appropriate to the item. The most common options are marker pens (UV or permanent), engraving or microtags.

### MAKE A LIST

Keep records of your valuables including a description of each item, any serial numbers and clear photos. Store your list in a safe place and provide it to Police if your property is stolen.

### WARNING

Place stickers in prominent places to warn that your property is marked. Large stickers can be placed near entry doors and small stickers on items.
