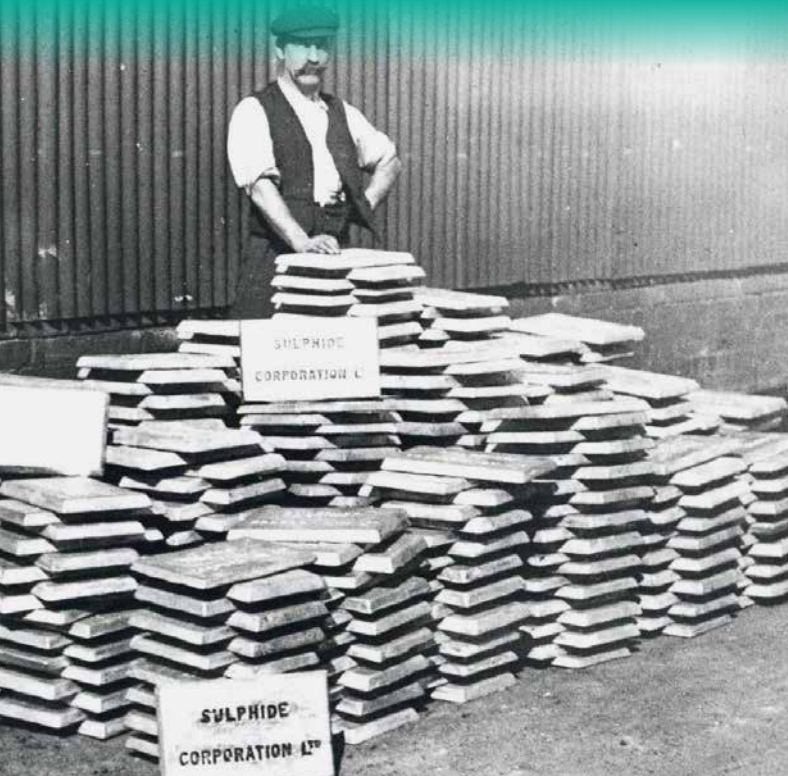

The Rover is available to visit schools to deliver storytime and literacy activities, and demonstrate technology. The Rover visits can be booked by calling 02 4921 0263.



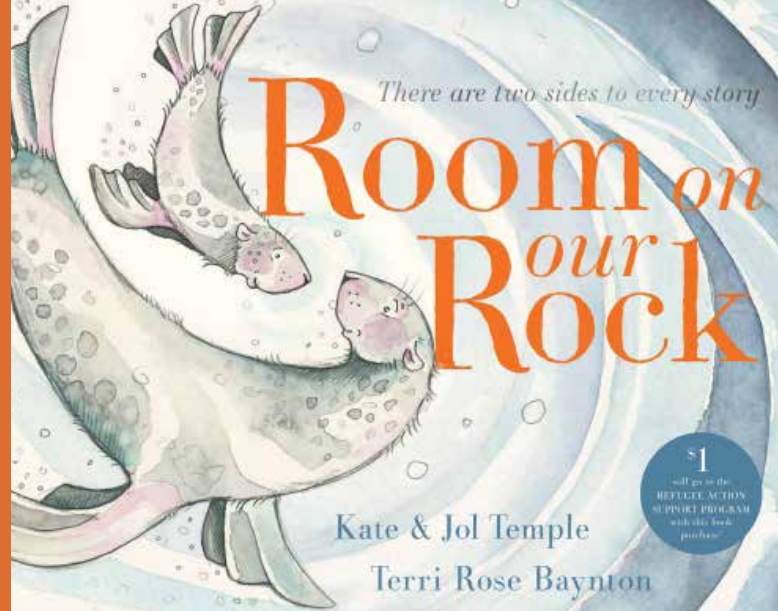
## Room On Our Rock - Book Week Live Puppet Show

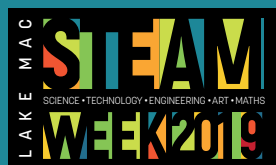
