

Memorial Garden Information

Ash Interment gardens are available for memorialisation and placement of ashes at **Belmont, Whitebridge,** and **West Wallsend** cemeteries.

Immediate Use is purchase of the niche place in the garden and purchase and installation of the plinth and ashes. If you reserve a space for future use (**pre-need/reservation**), you pay the garden place price only. Payment for the plinth and installation of the ashes will be required at the time of need/interment.

We can send you a location map that show available spaces to purchase. You can visit the cemetery and then contact council to confirm your tentative reservation and send an application. When the completed application and full payment is made, the Cemeteries Officer arranges the purchase of space, ordering of plinth, installation, and provision of Burial Licence.

Whitebridge Memorial Gardens



Niche Wall Gardens (1 to 4)



Boulder Garden (No.6)

Gardens 1 to 4 surround niche walls 5, 6, 9, 7, and 8. Garden 5 is a small irregular shaped garden located near the roadway and Garden 6 is a free form garden located under a gum tree with a memorial boulder

- Garden spaces are available for **immediate use** and for **pre-need** (reservation)

Belmont Memorial Gardens



A granite edge borders Memorial Garden 1 at Belmont Cemetery. The garden is located adjacent to the roadway and surrounds Walls 6, 10, and 5.

- Garden spaces are available for **immediate use** and for **pre-need** (reservation)

West Wallsend Memorial Garden

The memorial garden surrounds the niche wall located at the top of the cemetery

- Garden spaces are available for immediate use and for pre-need (reservation)
- Ash interments and reservations spaces will be placed progressively at the edge of the garden in a anti clockwise direction from the edge of the stamped path

Memorial Interment Information

- An ashes urn is interred (buried) into the garden and a granite plinth (plinth face measuring 200mm x 150mm) is installed for memorialisation
- The plinths will be installed in a staggered pattern
- There are four granite colours to choose from (black, emerald pearl, noble grey and blue pearl)
- Standard inscription is white or silver, gold inscription is available at an extra cost

Memorial Garden Conditions

- You are not allowed to place ornaments or other items in/on or around the Niche Wall, Boulder or Garden
- You are not allowed to interfere with or **remove** or **plant** any trees, shrubs, flowers etc in the Gardens
- No monuments can be erected in the gardens other than those allowed and supplied by council
- Council reserves the right to realign or alter the position of the garden and/or allotments at its discretion
- Council may remove and/or dispose of any unauthorised monument, memorial, plant, tribute etc without reference to any person
