Public Health Act 2010 regulated Premises – Regulation Requirements

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

Penalties apply for failure to notify under the Public Health Act 2010

Skin Penetration Premises:

Section 38 of the Public Health Act 2010 requires that a person carrying out skin penetration procedure must notify their local council of the following details:

- a. the address and telephone number of the premises,
- b. the name and contact details of the occupier of the premises (including residential address and home, business and mobile telephone numbers).
- c. the Australian Business Number (ABN) or Australian Company Number (ACN) (if any) of the occupier,
- d. the type of skin penetration procedures carried out at the premises,
- e. in the case of skin penetration procedures that are carried out in mobile premises, the local government areas in which the occupier of the premises intends to carry out the procedures.

Cooling Towers and Warm Water Systems:

Section 31 of the Public Health Act 2010 requires the occupier of premises where a system is installed to notify Council of the following details:

- a. the address and telephone number of the premises on which the system is installed,
- b. the name and contact details of the occupier of the premises (including residential address, e-mail address and home, business and mobile telephone numbers),
- c. the Australian Business Number (ABN) or Australian Company Number (ACN) (if any) of the occupier of the premises,
- d. the type of regulated system.

Public Swimming Pools and Spa Pools:

Section 20 of the Public Health Regulation 2012 requires that occupier of premises at which a public swimming pool or spa pool is situated must not allow a person to use the pool unless the occupier has notified their local council of the following details:

- a. the address and telephone number of the premises on which the public swimming pool or spa pool is located.
- b. the name and contact details of the occupier of the premises (including residential address, e-mail address and home, business and mobile telephone numbers),
- c. the Australian Business Number (ABN) or Australian Company Number (ACN) (if any) of the occupier of the premises.

Registration Fee

The Public Health Regulation 2012 has provision for Council to charge a fee for the initial notification of the regulated activity. The current fee is set out in Council's Fees & Charges document, which is available under the Policies & Publications section of Council's web site. An invoice for the registration fee will be forwarded to you upon receipt of your registration form.
