

BULKY WASTE SERVICE

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Council's bookable bulky waste service provides an opportunity to dispose of bulky household items.

You can choose to book a kerbside collection or receive a voucher to drop off waste at the Awaba Waste Management Facility. A drop-off voucher allows you to dispose of a wider range of items.

* Fridges, freezers and air-conditioners are only accepted kerbside if they have been professionally de-gassed by a technician licensed by the Australian Refrigeration Council.

Asbestos only option: You can use a drop-off voucher to dispose of up to 100kg of asbestos only. Strict booking and disposal conditions apply. No other types of bulk waste may be brought in with an asbestos load. Please call us or visit our website for more information. (Please note: asbestos is not permitted through the kerbside collection service).
